### **Sheanandoah ES Students Re-Enact Acadian Village**

**Baton Rouge, La. -- Shenandoah Elementary School** did something different recently to teach its students about the Acadian people of Louisiana and their history. They set up a hands-on **Petit Village on the school playground** in earlier this month. In the village, **students dressed in period costumes (*photo*)** and re-enacted the lives of Acadian villagers.
